### IT-SIDS

“IT-SIDS” (Infant Toddler Safe Sleep and SIDS Risk Reduction in Child Care) is a training developed by the NC Child Care Health and Safety Resource Center. It’s designed to help providers: understand what SIDS is; identify (and therefore reduce) external stressors and risk factors associated with SIDS; be aware of the NC Child Care Rules for a Safe Sleep Policy; understand how abiding by the NC Child Care Regulations reduces the risk of SIDS and suffocation; and be aware of the procedures for responding to an unresponsive infant and/or a SIDS death in child care. (2 credit hours)

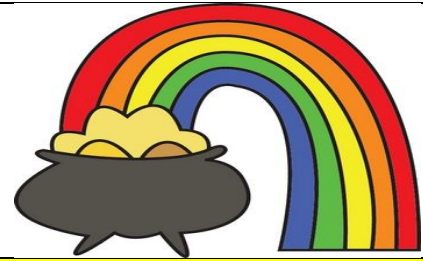

### Record Keeping and Monitoring

Record Keeping and Monitoring is a mandatory training to discuss record keeping, monitoring tools, and serious deficiency policies. (2 Credit hours)

### Cultural Competence

This course is designed as a five-hour course. This course is a beginning step to preparing the early childhood workforce to increase their awareness and understanding of culture and cultural competence. It focuses on defining culture, cultural conditioning and culturally responsive teaching and the role of engaging families. It is designed to be interactive and self-reflective. Children from diverse backgrounds — including children of color, children of lower socioeconomics, and children of marginalized groups — continue to be cared for and educated in early learning environments that are not providing the diversity of experiences that reflect their cultural backgrounds, which includes family values and learning styles. This course was developed by Glover and Associates, Inc. through the CCBSC funded by the Early Learning Race to the Top Grant. This course focuses on the specific stage of Awareness in the Cultural Competence BSC Conceptual Framework and the process for developing culturally responsive teaching practices in Early Childhood Education. (5 credit hours)

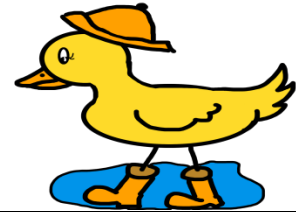

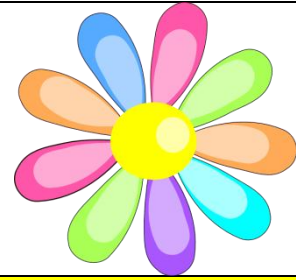
